The Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, an 11-member conference of NCAA Division II institutions located in Missouri and Kansas, embarks upon its 96th season of competition this fall.

First organized in 1912 as the Missouri Intercollegiate Athletic Association, the league has undergone several changes since the 1990s, highlighted by expansion and increased participation in national championships.

The MIAA has gained recognition as one of the top NCAA Division II athletic conferences in the nation, producing seven National Championship teams since the 1990s – Pittsburg State University in football ('91), Missouri Southern State University in women's softball ('92), the University of Central Missouri in baseball ('94, '03), Northwest Missouri State University in football ('98-99) and Washburn in women's basketball ('05) – as well as numerous individual NCAA Division II Champions and All-Americans.

The MIAA conducts conference championships in eight men's and nine women's sports. Men's champions are crowned in football, cross country, basketball, indoor and outdoor track and field, baseball, tennis and golf. Women's championships are held in volleyball, cross country, basketball, indoor and outdoor track and field, soccer, softball, tennis and golf.

**Jim Johnson** enters his third year as commissioner of the MIAA. Johnson previously served as athletic director at Texas A&M University-Commerce (2005-07) and as assistant athletic director at Central Missouri (2003-05). He also was a long-time staff member of the NCAA in membership services.

**Natasha Oakes** is in her fifth year with the conference, her second as Assistant Commissioner for Internal Operations/Senior Woman Administrator. **Larry House** enters his second year with the MIAA, his first as Assistant Commissioner for Championships and Business Development.

**Kellen Coleman** begins his first year as Media Relations Coordinator for the conference.

## NCAA Division II Tournament Appearances

The Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association has been well represented in the NCAA Division II National Tournament throughout the history of the conference.

The MIAA boasts a national champion as well as eight national runners-up from the last 52 seasons of play.

The 1956-57 season marked the first year that a national champion basketball team was crowned in NCAA Division II.

Central Missouri, which leads all current MIAA schools with 19 post-season appearances, captured the 1983-84 NCAA Division II national title — the same season that UCM won the women's national championship. (It still stands as the only season in which the men's and women's NCAA-II titles were won by the same school.)

In all, the MIAA has been represented 110 times in NCAA-II post-season play.

Former MIAA member Missouri State, now an NCAA Division I member, finished as the national runner-up five times. MSU's runner-up finishes were in 1958-59, '60-61, '66-67, '68-69 and '73-74.

Former conference member Southeast Missouri, now an NCAA Division I member, also has finished as the national runner-up twice — in '85-86 and '88-89. UCM reached the Division II Final Four in 2009.
