SCOUTING TARLETON STATE

Tarleton State (0-0) returns two starters from a squad that went 16-12 in 2008-09. After losing their two leading scorers, the TexAnns will look to junior Brittanie Haley (returning to the hardwood after a one year absence) and sophomores Shelby Adamson and Tori Skarke to emerge as leaders for the young team.

After a convincing 69-41 win over UT-Dallas (a D-II South Central regional qualifier in 2008-09) in exhibition, the TexAnns have high hopes for 2009-10, provided that they can avoid the inconsistency that plagues many young teams.

SCOUTING TEXAS WOMAN'S

Texas Woman's (1-0) returns six of the top eight scorers, led by seniors Keshia Bolds, Jessica Durr and Meghan Hashman, from a team that went 16-11 in 2009-10. The 16 wins were the most since 1989 for the Pioneers who were picked to finish fifth in the preseason Lone Star Conference polls.

The Pioneers started the exhibition season strong with a 79-75 upset over Division-I North Texas then followed it with a 98-50 drubbing of LeTourneau. In their regular season opener, TWU edged Harding 74-70 using a balanced scoring attack, with five players in double figures.

Texas Woman's small, but quick team has a dangerous scoring attack that will look to challenge the top teams in the Lone Star Conference in 2009-10.

SCOUTING PITT STATE

Pitt State returns two starters and five letterwinners from last season's squad that produced one of the best turnarounds in school history. The Gorillas finished third in the MIAA and made it to the semifinals of the MIAA Tournament before their season was ended by Washburn.

In addition, the Gorillas gain back three impact players who were out last season due to ACL injuries and add six new players, two of whom will start the Gorillas season opener.

In three exhibition games against Division I teams from the Big 12 North, the Gorillas had two players average double figures. Freshman Drew Roberts led the team with 12.3 points per game, while senior Nicole McCombs averaged 11.7 ppg. Newcomer Maya Onikute led the team with 5.7 rebounds per game. Onikute also led the team with eight assists over the three games.

THERE'S A FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

Pittsburg State has never played Tarleton State nor Texas Woman's University in Women's Basketball.

LAST TIME OUT

A three-point play by senior DePrice Taylor with nine seconds on the clock proved to be the winning score, as the Pittsburg State women's basketball team (1-0) defeated No. 12 Central Oklahoma (0-1), 70-69, in the Gorilla's season opener Sunday (Nov. 15) afternoon at John Lance Arena.

The Gorillas trailed the Brochos by two with less than 30 seconds left in the game. Senior Maya Onikute missed a three-point shot, but crashed the boards to grab her own rebound and give Pitt State another chance with 17 second remaining. Taylor found a hole in the UCO defense and drove the lane to hit the game-tying layup. She was fouled by Central Oklahoma's Alyssa Fuxa. After a UCO time out, Taylor stepped up to the lane and calmly sunk the charity shot, giving Pitt State the lead. UCO's Cristina Yarbrough attempted a three at the buzzer, but it fell short, giving the Gorillas the win.

Onikute led PSU with 20 points and 10 rebounds. Freshman Drew Roberts, who hit two consecutive threes in the game's waning minutes, finished the game with 19 points. She hit 5-of-9 from three points range and also led the Gorillas with five assists. Senior Nicole McCombs recorded a double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds. She scored eight of her 12 points in the first half.

There were two ties and seven lead changes in the first half before Pittsburg State grabbed the lead for good at 23-22 on a Roberts three with 4:45 to go. The Gorillas stretched their lead to as many as eight as Roberts drained another three with 2:13 to go. The Bronchos closed the gap slightly, but Pitt State was able to take a 34-30 lead in the the lockerroom at the half.

The second half saw six ties, but Central Oklahoma had the advantage most of the half. The Bronchos led by as many as seven with just over 10 minutes to go in the game and by five with 4:30 to go. A Roberts jumper and a traditional three-point play by Onikute tied the game at 59-59 with 3:07 remaining. UCO's Jordan Stark hit shot from beyond the arc to put her team in the lead again.

The two teams traded free throws, leaving the Bronchos still in the lead by three at 64-61 with 1:59 to go. A Kasey Tweed layup was sandwiched between two Roberts threes, both assisted by Onikute to give the Gorillas a one-point lead at 67-66. Courtney Allen hit a three for UCO to give her team the 69-67 advantage before Taylor's heroics, and her only three points of the game, gave Pittsburg State its third consecutive season-opening win.

PRESEASON POLL

The Pittsburg State University women's basketball team drew the No. 3 pick by both conference coaches and media representatives in the 2009-10 MIAA Preseason Polls, released Tuesday (Oct. 27) at the Downtown Marriott.

The Gorillas received three first-place votes and 86 total points in balloting of the MIAA's 11 coaches. Pitt State earned one first place vote and 236 points in voting among 28 regional media representatives.

Emporia State University earned the preseason No. 1 ranking in both polls, while Washburn University was tabbed second in each poll.

Pitt State posted a breakthrough 20-9 record during the 2008-09 season, advancing to the semifinals of the MIAA Tournament under second-year head coach Lane Lord. The Gorillas notched their first 20-win season in a decade and narrowly missed qualifying for the NCAA-II National Tournament.

"I think expectations are very high in our third year," said Lord. "With the players we have returning, like Nicole McCombs and DePrice Taylor, I think people are recognizing that we have good quality depth. It is flattering to get three first-place votes from the coaches and have our colleagues recognize that we can compete and the top of the league."

McCombs returns for her senior season after earning first-team All-MIAA honors as a junior last year. She averaged a team-leading 15.7 points and 7.2 rebounds per game last season.

"It is nice to see that Pitt State is gaining respect among the coaches and media in the MIAA," McCombs said. "We appreciate the recognition, but hope to exceed expectations."

PSU IN EXHIBITION GAMES

The Gorillas played three exhibition games against teams from the Big 12 Conference. The Gorillas went 0-3 in those games, but got good experience against tough competition.

Pitt State fell to Kansas, 86-56. Nicole McCombs led the Gorillas with 11 points, while Maya Onikute and Larissa Richards shared the rebounding lead with six a piece.

Against Nebraska, the Gorillas lost 68-54, but played much better basketball. PSU trailed the Huskers by only three points with 11 minutes left in the game. Drew Roberts led the team with 17 points, while Laura Glenn led with seven rebounds.

The Gorillas led Kansas State for most of the first half, before poor shooting and turnovers helped them to a 89-61 loss to the Wildcats. McCombs again led the team in scoring, this time with 12 points. Onikute was the leading rebounder with nine.

Over the three exhibition games, Roberts led the team with 12.3 ppg and hit eight threes. while shooting .412 from the floor. McCombs was the only other player averaging double figures with 11.7 ppg. Maya Onikute led the team with 5.7 rpg and 2.7 apg.

UP NEXT

On Nov. 24, Pitt State hosts Arkansas-Fort Smith (0-0) in Pittsburg, Kan. at John Lance Arena. Tip-off is scheduled for 6 p.m. Arkansas-Fort Smith plays in the UA Monticello Classic before facing the Gorillas next week.
