## 2010 Pitt State Invitational

- SITE:** Weede Physical Education Building / Lance Arena -- Pittsburg State University
- ADMISSIONS:** \$4.00 per person, 12 & Under and College Students with a Valid Student ID are Free Spectators and Team Seating is in the mezzanine of the Weede Physical Education Building
- STARTING TIME:** Field Events 12:00 p.m. Running Events 5:00 p.m.
- ENTRY FEE:** \$15.00 per athlete (maximum of \$150 per team). Pay fee at registration table on meet day

Follow the instructions listed on that web site. Entries will be accepted on the web site beginning February 1 and **ending at 7:00 p.m., Wednesday, Feb. 10**. No additions or substitutions will be taken after this time. Unlimited entries. Unattached athletes are welcome. This is an open meet. You must have corresponding TFRRS ID numbers for all athletes trying to qualify for NCAA I and NCAA II National Championships. **Minimum marks in field events may be used to keep meet on schedule. If needed, minimum marks will be emailed to coaches prior to the meet. Please enter marks that you feel your athletes are capable of performing at this time.**

**New NCAA Legislation:** NCAA Div. I and II must obtain TFRRS ID's for all team members before entering the meet. Go to [www.tfrrs.org](http://www.tfrrs.org) and follow instructions. You will be able to download your team roster and TFRRS ID #'s into the meet entry website.

**NCAA Rule: Section 1. Misconduct:** Misconduct is any act of dishonesty, unsportsmanlike conduct, unprofessional behavior or breach of law occurring at the locale of the competition or warm-up, that discredits the event or intercollegiate athletics. **Acts of misconduct are subject to reprimand or ejection by the referee or meet management.**

- DECLARATIONS:** Coaches **must declare** their teams on the entry web site. The declaration deadline is **Wednesday, Feb. 10 at 7:00 p.m.** A revised time schedule will be posted after entries are received.
- TRACK SURFACE:** Track is a 160m polyurethane oval and runways. Oval has 6 Lanes and the Straight has 7 lanes. 7 athletes will be taken to finals in all field events.
- THROWING AREAS:** Shot put and the weight throw are off of wood platforms.
- IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN:** All implements will be weighed in and certified in the southeast corner of the arena from 10:30 until 11:30 a.m.
- SCORING:** No team scores will be kept.
- TRAINER:** A trainer will be available during the meet. Please bring your own supplies such as tape, etc.
- FACILITIES:** Dressing and shower facilities will be available. Bring own towels and locks for lockers.

**SPIKES:** 1/8" or 1/4" pyramid spikes only. Needle and "Christmas Tree" spikes are prohibited.
