3. **PLAY HARD AND HAVE FUN!**

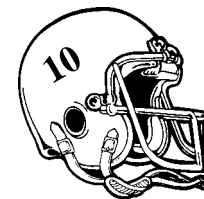
## TRAINING STAFF

During the last 14 seasons, Pittsburg State University has averaged 7,950 fans per home game (667,798 fans in 84 games). Last year, PSU averaged 7,821 fans in five home games, (including one game at Arrowhead Stadium, 20,813), ranking in the top 5 nationally of NCAA Division II.
