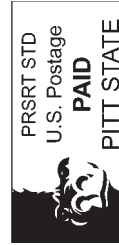

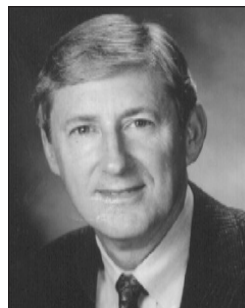

BASKETBALL CAMP STAFF



Gene Iba, Head Basketball Coach

Gene Iba recently completed his fourteenth season as the head basketball coach at Pittsburg State University.

Iba became PSU's ninth head basketball coach in school history in July of 1995 and he has quickly established a solid foundation for the Gorilla Basketball Program.

The Gorillas, who have made five trips to the NCAA Division II National Tournament, have established themselves as one of the most-successful team in the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association and the South Central Region of Division II during Coach Iba's tenure. Iba, twice named the MIAA Coach of the Year, has averaged 19 wins per season during his tenure. He led PSU to its first MIAA title and the No. 1 ranking in Division II during the 1998-99 campaign and again in 2004-05.

PSU's quick transformation under Coach Iba's leadership has come as no surprise to those associated with him. Success has followed him in each of his previous assignments, as he developed winning programs for both of his NCAA Division I predecessors - Baylor University and Houston Baptist University.

Following his 29th season as a collegiate head coach, Iba has guided teams into post-season competition nine times, including a pair of trips to the NCAA Division I March Madness and PSU's five trips to the Division II National Tournament.



Derek Joiner, Assistant Coach

Derek Joiner enters his fifth season as the third assistant for the Pittsburg State University basketball program. Joiner comes to PSU following a stay at Okalahoma State University as the senior manager and graduate assistant for the OSU basketball program.



Matt Brock, Assistant Coach

Matt Brock is in his first season as an assistant at Pittsburg State. Brock joined the Gorillas after serving as an assistant at Hannibal-LaGrange College (MO), after a successful playing career at Truman State.

GENE IBA TEAM CAMP

This advanced team camp is designed for high school teams competing at the varsity and junior varsity levels.

Each team is guaranteed a minimum of eight games over the span of three days. Teams will be divided into Varsity and Junior Varsity divisions upon request.

The focus of the camp is to provide an atmosphere that will allow teams to begin building and improving their skills for the upcoming season.

Each team will be required to have a supervisor/coach to monitor actions of their team, both on and off the floor.

New KSHAA rules allow High School coaches to coach there own teams at summer team camps.
