



Pittsburg, Kansas, is centrally located between the metropolitan areas of Kansas City, Tulsa, Wichita and Springfield.

- From Kansas City: take US-69 south. (approx. 108 mi.)
- From Springfield: take I-44 west to US-71 North, then go west on Business US-71 at Carthage to MO-171. Continue west on MO-171 (becomes K-57 in Kan.) to US 69 N. to Pittsburg. (approx. 100 mi.)
- From the Joplin Airport, take MO-171 west (becomes K-57 in Kan.) to US-69 N. to Pittsburg.

- From Tulsa: Take I-44 E to US-69 N. (Exit 301). Take US-69 N. to Pittsburg. Alternately, take I-44 E to the US-166/US-400 exit. (approx. 135 mi.)

- From Wichita: Take US-400 E to US-69 N. (approx. 168 mi.)
