## **Grand Valley's Anes, C.W. Post's Smart Headline 2002 Football Gazette All-Northeast Region Team**

CLARION, Pa. — Harlon Hill Award winning quarterback Curt Anes from Grand Valley State (Mich.) and Harlon Hill Runner-Up running back Ian Smart of C.W. Post headline a talented 2002 Northeast Region team selected by *Don Hansen's Football Gazette*.

This marks the first year *Football Gazette* has selected NCAA Division II All-Region teams. The national publication has selected NCAA Division II All-America teams since 1988.

The first team and second team selections advance to a national ballot from which the 2002 NCAA Division II *Football Gazette* All-America team will be selected later this month.

Anes, a senior from Kentwood, Mich., was selected as the top Division II Player (Harlon Hill Award) and led Grand Valley State to the Division II National Championship with a 14-0 record and a 31-24 win in the title game against Valdosta State.

Anes ended the season completing 278 of 414 passes (67.5%) for 3,692 yards and 47 TDs. He is the all-time leader in D-II in total offense with 11,883 yards, second all-time in TD passes (114) and 6th in passing yards (10,583).

Smart, the Harlon Hill runner-up, led C.W. Post to its first NCAA Division II playoff berth and helped his team finish with an 11-1 record. The senior from North Babylon, N.Y., led Division II in rushing with 2,023 yards and 30 TDs on 287 carries. Smart finished his career as the all-time leader in college football history with 95 touchdowns and 570 points scored. He is fourth all-time in rushing yards (6,647).

Other unanimous choices selected on the first team included Grand Valley State wide receiver David Kircus, Clarion offensive tackle Reggie Wells, and tight end Kory Wright of Concord on offense. Return specialist Rob Carey of Lock Haven and punter Sean McNicholas of Edinboro were unanimous choices on special teams.

A total of 81 players representing 38 football-playing universities in the Northeast Region are honored on this team.
