Saginaw Valley's Radlinsky, Mansfield's Holland Headline 2003 Football Gazette All-Northeast Region Team

CLARION, Pa. — Harlon Hill Trophy finalist quarterback Mark Radlinsky from Saginaw Valley State (Mich.) and linebacker Dan Holland from Mansfield (Pa.) headline a talented 2003 Northeast Region team selected by *Don Hansen's Football Gazette*.

This marks the second year that *Football Gazette* has selected NCAA Division II All-Region Teams. The national publication has selected NCAA Division II All-America teams since 1988.

The first and second team selections will advance to a national ballot from which the 2003 NCAA Division II All-America team will be selected from within the next two weeks.

Radlinsky, who finished sixth in the Harlon Hill balloting, led Saginaw Valley to a 12-1 record and set all new school records while completing 253 of 410 passes for 3,428 yards and 32 touchdowns.

Holland, who collected 132 tackles, 10 tackles-for-loss, two quarterback sacks, and three blocked kicks finished fourth in the Hill Trophy balloting, the highest placing for a defensive player since Ronald McKinnon (North Alabama/Arizona Cardinals) earned the Harlon Hill Trophy in 1995.

Clarion defensive lineman Troy Bowers and Grand Valley State safety Scott Mackey and defensive lineman Keyonta Marshall, who helped lead the Lakers to back-to-back NCAA Division II National Championships (2002-03), are repeat first-team selections on this year's team.

A total of 19 different teams are represented on this year's first team, while 87 players representing 35 teams in the vast Northeast Region comprise the 2003 squad.
