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Hill Trophy Finalist Scott, Hill Trophy Winner Woodhead Headline 2007 Football Gazette All-Southwest Region Team

PITTSBURG, Kan. — Harlon Hill Trophy finalist tailback Bernard Scott of Abilene Christian University and Harlon Hill Trophy winning running back Danny Woodhead of Chadron State College headline a talented 2007 All-Southwest Region Team selected by *Don Hansen's Football Gazette*.

This marks the sixth year *Football Gazette* has selected NCAA Division II All-Region teams. The national publication, an authority on small college football, has selected NCAA Division II All-America teams since 1998.

The first-team and second-team All-Region selections advance to a national ballot from which the 2007 NCAA Division II *Football Gazette* All-America team will be named in mid-January.

Scott, a junior from Vernon, Texas, rushed 251 times for a Lone Star Conference record 2,165 yards, while helping the Wildcats to a 10-3 record and an NCAA-II second-round playoff appearance. He scored an NCAA-II record 234 points on the season, with 35 rushing touchdowns and a record 39 TDs overall. Scott finished a distant second to Woodhead in the Hill Trophy vote.

Woodhead, a senior from North Platte, Neb., became just the third player in Division II history to claim the Harlon Hill Trophy in back-to-back seasons (2006-07). Woodhead set the NCAA all-division all-time career rushing record (7,962 yards) in 2007, carrying the ball 250 times for 1,597 yards and 21 touchdowns, despite missing two games due to injury. He also finished his career two points short of the NCAA all-division all-time career scoring record (658 pts.) with 656 points, while helping the Eagles to a second straight 12-1 season and repeat appearance in the NCAA-II national quarterfinals.

National Runner-up Northwest Missouri State University of the MIAA led the way with 10 honorees, including seven first-team selections. Lone Star Conference member Abilene Christian University also had 10 all-region recipients – three first-team honorees. RMAC champion Chadron State, the regional runner-up, LSC champion West Texas A&M University, Mesa State College of the RMAC and Tarleton State University of the LSC also had seven selections apiece on the All-Region teams.

A total of 94 players earned some form of *Football Gazette* All-Southwest Region honors. Players from 25 of the 35 football-playing schools in the Southwest Region earned All-Southwest Region accolades.
